Atrocities have been happening at the border for many years, but on May 7th of this year, a “zero tolerance” policy went into place, leading to rapid mass incarceration at the border. Currently, over 10,000 immigrant children are being held in US custody away from their families. Although the family separation policy ended on June 20<sup>th</sup>, whole families are still being detained and interned at the alarming rate of 1000-1,500 people per day! As many as half of these prisoners are children.

### CARAVANS

**We are calling for people to caravan out to the nearest kids internment camp or ICE facility on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.** Once the caravans reach the kids internment camps, our goal is to bring comfort to the children as best we can. We will hold vigil outside the camps, and sing lullabies in Spanish and other Latin American languages. We will also attempt to get toys and Spanish-language books in to them.

- **Berkeley Caravan #1.** A caravan will depart from BFUU (1924 Ceder Street, Berkeley) at around 1pm on July 1st, following the Sunday service and brunch. (Come at 10:30am if you want to join for the Sunday service.)
